Sunday, July 29th:

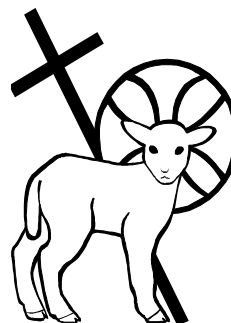

#### National VdC Coordinator Update

Since last summer, our community took the next step towards the idea that we establish the position of a National VdC Coordinator. The minutes from the August Conexiones reflected the discussion and then unanimous support and approval to continue with the process. So what do we do next?

**First**, we know we need to hold a national fundraising campaign with a goal of establishing an endowment fund to pay for this position. **Second**, we need individuals who have some previous experience in non-profit capital campaigns or fund drives, and/or have the ability and talents to help us make this happen. The Board was empowered to seek, find, and have trained some individuals that would like to work on this fund raising campaign. **Third**, we have a source for training and will have you trained with the knowledge you need to proceed. Please don't let not having the experience or lack of training be a deterrent from stepping forward! **Fourth**, the establishment of an Ad-Hoc Committee of people who are willing to be trained in fundraising.

Nationwide over 84,000 have participated in a VdC weekend. So far two people have expressed some interest and we need *8 to 10 additional* people with the passion, desire and enthusiasm to be a part of the Ad-Hoc Committee. Without your willingness to volunteer this project will not be able to move forward. Without the money we will not be able to develop this position.

## NLS Board Minutes

### Tele-Conference Call Minutes February 18, 2007

Present: Larry Witham, Dave Erdman, Nanette Helgager, Judy Laabs-Foss, Jerry Lemcke, Jan Long, and Pastor John Propst.

The meeting opened with prayer requests and prayer by Pastor John Propst at 8:02 p.m.

Secretary's Report –2006 Annual Surveys were sent to all Lay Directors and are in the process of being returned. To date, 19 Secretariats have been received. Follow-up is happening with the others. All minutes to date have been and approved, published in the newsletter and posted on the web site.

Treasurer's Report – Membership dues reminders have been sent to treasurers. 4 secretariats have sent fees in. Account balances are as follows: The Thrivent account is at \$15,808.16, the business interest checking account is at \$5,108.00, the advantage checking account (that was set up for a Fund Raiser) is \$918.00. An article was placed into the January newsletter stating that we are open to contributions towards the National Coordinator Position Fund Raiser.

VP of Administration's Report – INKY's host committee has been meeting. They report that they are doing well. One registration form has been received to date. Final registration form looks good. The host committee will notify persons interested in staying an extra night of the additional cost. Annual meeting schedule has been e-mailed to board members. The basic schedule has not yet been updated. Speakers who have agreed to give talks are Bob Quam, Wes Bucher, and Jim Ryan with a panel. Suggested names for Spiritual Direction talk will be welcomed. Pastor John will stay in touch with Nu regarding a prospective speaker. Outlines and information will be sent to the speakers in a few weeks by Nu. Forum will be presented in the form of an interview. Details of the weekend and room assignments will be prepared in a few weeks. The new "Christ is Counting on You" DVD has been receiving very positive feedback. Discussion was held regarding the re-grouping of movements in a few different regions. The goal is to provide better support within a couple of regions.

VP of Outreach's Report – Via de Cristo of the Rockies in Colorado has signed the constitution and is very well organized. Western Wisconsin has been going to the Minnesota weekends and they would like to have weekends in Wisconsin. They also have very experienced people in their new movement. They are looking to forming a secretariat within 6 months. Maryland and Pennsylvania are showing interest in starting a new movement. Rainbow VdC is in support of this. A new movement is also being considered in Pennsylvania. Dave has sent the new DVD to them. A personal invitation to the annual meeting is suggested. Spiritual Directors are very important to a movement. Northern Light's constitution will be mailed to Jan. The e-version of the constitution will be sent to board members. A contact will be made to interested people in England. Interest was also expressed in Florida.

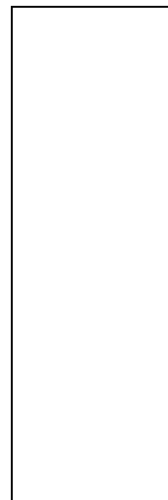
