

YOU & THRIVENT MAKING A DIFFERENCE IN COMMUNITY

For many years our Via de Cristo's National Lutheran Secretariat has maintained a valued partnership with Thrivent Financial. Dating back to the early 2000's, many Annual Gathering Host Committees have received "grants" from Thrivent. This generosity is a treasured tool for Host Committees to help meet fund-raising goals needed to host our Annual Gatherings. Since 2013, Thrivent has revised their benevolence to widen and broaden the impact by opening its membership and services to people of all Christian faiths.

Thrivent's giving model focuses on two compatible platforms: Thrivent Choice Dollars® and Thrivent Action Teams. Through the first option, Choice Dollars®, Thrivent distributes a portion of its charitable funding by directing Choice Dollars® to organizations recommended by Thrivent members. Donations are based on insurance premiums, contract values and Thrivent volunteer leadership and then get disbursed directly to organizations recommended by Thrivent members for causes they care about. More than 40,000 churches and nonprofits are enrolled in the program and it keeps growing. The second and a more locally directed option to Thrivent members involves *Thrivent Action Teams*. This process starts with an individual asking a simple question: "Who can I help and how?". Once a need in the community is identified, volunteers brainstorm ideas to address it and present

their ideas to Thrivent. Thrivent Action Teams can be provided with seed money to jump-start a fundraiser, an educational event or even service project. A volunteer team provides the people power and Thrivent provides the capital to bring it to life.

Here are a couple examples of Thrivent Action Teams among Via de Cristo. One VdC community used its "seed" money to buy food for an Ultreya so those attending could give generously to their VdC Scholarship Fund. Another Action Team bought stamps for a mass mailing inviting 450 current and inactive 4th Day members to an upcoming Ultreya and if someone was no longer in the area asking them to donate to their Scholarship Fund. A side benefit to this mailing was to give the community the ability to clean-up their mailing list. And a final example is when an Annual Gathering's Transportation Team applied for an Action Team Grant to help pay for golf cart rentals to assist attendees to navigate the college campus.

Once your project is approved, you'll receive a Thrivent Action Kit that includes:

- A promotional pennant banner
- Thank you cards, name tags, and stickers
- Thrivent Action Team T-shirts
- \$250 Community Impact Card for seed money to get your project off the ground

Each full member of Thrivent can lead an Action Team twice a year. At the end of your project(s), a short report needs to be written consisting of the project's goal, the number of people who participated and the

projects outcome.

Once pin pointing a need, then apply to lead your Thrivent Action Team to make it easy to live generously on your *Wise With Money Journey*. GIVE OF YOURSELF
On your Wise With Money Journey, giving back to the causes and people you care most about can start with one simple question: "Who can I help?"



Hey! Did you read the above article? If so, are you are thinking how Thrivent Financial offers its members a charitable giving opportunity that sounds an awful lot like Palanca?

Since Via de Cristo talks a lot about Palanca, let's take a moment to explore this term. When we made our very first weekend, we learn that Palanca is a Spanish word that basically represents the prayers and sacrifices we make for someone or something. In short, however, the Spanish translation for Palanca is "lever."

Are you thinking that that's quite a stretch from lever to prayer? Well, a lever (Palanca) is a fixed body

(typically a metal bar) pivoted on a fixed fulcrum used to move or lift an object. In the same way a lever enables a person to lift something beyond his or her strength, our "Palanca" prayers and sacrifices allow someone to overcome more than he or she could do on their own. Your prayer Palanca help to make someone else's life arise in abundance.

Spiritual Palanca can come in many forms. In the Catholic faith, Palanca letters are written by family members or friends of a person who is retreating or withdrawing from ordinary activities for a period of time. Such letters give support and guidance in the form of a prayer, sacrifice and honest communication and to spend time in reflection and prayer to God.

Bear in mind that letters in and of themselves are not Palanca!

Palanca means a prayer, letter, or sacrifice done to exert spiritual force for Christ's sake. Palanca practice is embraced by the Cursillo Movement (CM) of the Catholic church which, per www.cursillos.ca/en/faq/f01-but.htm the goal of which is to "share with the community the essence of Christianity and Christian values and in this way gradually transform the community from within."
